Pay-as-you-go lighting arrives at Schiphol

Schiphol Group, Cofely, and Philips have sealed a lease agreement for the Amsterdam airport's new LED terminal lighting.

Schiphol worked with Philips and architecture practice Kossman De Long to design lighting with 75% longer lifespan.

Schiphol pays for the lighting it uses, while Philips retains ownership of all fixtures and installations of the sustainable lights. Philips and Cofely are responsible for operational performance and on-site management of the energy-efficient LED lamps, which should see a 50% efficiency improvement compared with conventional light fixtures. "At the same time they will also be responsible for the intensity and reliability of the lighting, based on a KPI [key performance indicator] model," Philips stated.
